**F**or Andrew Suvalsky, design is more than just a pretty face. "It should not be a two-dimensional picture that is just pretty. It should also be comfortable and livable," explains the 38-year-old, whose design career began after answering a help-wanted ad led to a job as an assistant for Benjamin Noriega-Ortiz. "My finished product should represent the clients so authentically that it is truly home for them." And for his own Lower East Side residence, warm colors marry with clean lines for a laid-back feel. The texture of the ultrasuede chocolate-brown sectional complements the high-gloss finish on the Venetian plastered wall. A custom table with a driftwood base and a graphic 48-inch by 54-inch pop art canvas are the telling marks of a designer's touch.

A duo of putty-colored leather chairs from 440 Antiques blends into a shag rug from Architectural Flooring. A custom coffee table from All Driftwood Furniture sits on top. An antique table lamp from Elizabeth 260 Antiques and a Flos floor lamp combine for ideal illumination.
